Golf Week Rules and Conditions of Entry.

- Closing date for entries from members is Saturday 30th June 2012.
- Closing date for entries from visitors is Wednesday 4th July 2012.
- Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the club.
- Competitions are open only to members of recognised clubs.
- All entries must be accompanied by valid handicap certificate.
- All visitors will be made temporary members of the club.
- Ballots for start times + partners will be posted in the Clubhouse from Friday 6th July 2012.
- No player may win more than 1 prize in any stroke play competition.
- All trophies will be held at the winner's club, but remain the property of Stornoway Golf Club and shall be returned by them by 6th July.
- Ties will be decided as follows:
 - stroke play scratch : 4 hole stroke play then sudden death over holes 1,2,17,18...
 - stroke play handicap : last 9, last 6, last 3, first 9, first 6, first 3
 - match play : sudden death from first hole
- The decision of the Stornoway Golf Club committee is final.
- The committee reserve the right to alter details, format and/or times of any competition.
